What is Picture Day?

Picture Day is a super fun, magical studio event where dancers get all dressed up in their recital costumes and take professional photos to celebrate their season. Our professional photographer, **Victor Jacek Photography**, will be onsite to capture both class photos and individual portraits of your little dancer, highlighting their personality, progress, and all the hard work they've put into the year. It's a joyful, relaxed experience filled with smiles, encouragement, and a little bit of sparkle. Our dancers get to feel like stars for the day, and you'll walk away with beautiful memories and keepsakes to treasure forever.

Picture Day is free event hosted by the studio as part of celebrating your dancer's season of growth, joy, and hard work. All photos will be available after the event for purchase directly from our photographer.

How it Works

- Each class will have a scheduled time and dancers should arrive camera-ready for their photo shoot. When you walk in, the studio will already be transformed into a professional photography space, complete with lights, cameras, and fun props designed to bring out each dancer's personality.
- We'll begin with a class photo, followed by individual portraits so every dancer has their moment to shine. Each dancer will be guided through 2–3 different poses, plus a headshot, giving you a beautiful variety of images to choose from. The goal of Picture Day is to capture each dancer's unique spirit, confidence, and joy.
- Miss Lucy will be there throughout the day, supporting the photographer and helping each dancer feel comfortable, confident, and like a true supermodel in front of the camera.
- About 2–4 weeks after Picture Day, you will receive a digital photo gallery where you can view and order your favorite images and prints.

What to Wear?

Dancers will be photographed in their recital costumes as they would appear on recital day – including show hair and makeup, show tights, and dance shoes.

Here is a couple reminders to help your dancer dress for success:

- Stage-ready hair is required
- Light makeup for picture day (a little blush, lipstick, and simple eye makeup to help dancers shine under the photographer's lights – no full stage makeup needed)
- No nail polish, temporary tattoos, jewelry, or underwear under dance tights for Picture Day
- Dance shoes must not be worn outside. Keep dance shoes in your bag until you arrive at the studio.
- Always bring a few “fix-it” essentials to any recital event when in costume – like hairspray, hair ties, bobby pins, and lipstick. Little things can happen, and being prepared helps keep your dancer photo-ready and feeling confident all day long!

Ordering Pictures

Your Digital Photo Gallery will be delivered to your email inbox approximately 2–4 weeks after Picture Day, where you'll be able to view and purchase your favorites.

Photo Use & Participation Guidelines

- Families have the right to use and share purchased images for personal, non-commercial use. We encourage respectful sharing of group photos that include other dancers.
- Because the studio invests in hosting Picture Day and offers this experience at no cost to our families, please note images may be shared by Miss Lucy's School of Dance and our photographer, Victor Jacek Photography, to celebrate and promote the joy of our studio, including use on social media, our website, and in portfolio or marketing materials. Families may opt out of commercial use for individual photos.
- Participation in the class photo is completely optional; however, if your dancer participates in the class photo, that image may be used for promotional and marketing purposes. We encourage all dancers to be part of the class photo, but if your family prefers not to participate in the class photo due to photo sharing or commercial use, we fully respect your choice. We take our families' media preferences very seriously. Please note that class photos used for marketing are shared as captured and are not edited, covered, blurred, or altered.
- A one-time Picture Day photo release must be signed prior to participation. This form is separate from the studio's Media Release and applies only to Picture Day photography.

Getting Ready

To help the day run smoothly (and keep things stress-free for our dancers), please have your child arrive at the studio fully dressed and ready to go – hair and makeup done, with costume and recital tights on. With professional photography equipment set up and only one studio restroom, space will be limited on Picture Day. We kindly ask that families do not plan on dressing their dancer or doing hair/makeup at the studio.

Dancers with multiple costumes should arrive in their first scheduled costume and bring all additional costumes with them. Dancers will change at the studio between their scheduled photo times.

Parents Info

Please plan to stay on-site during Picture Day (no matter your dancer's age). **Due to studio capacity, each dancer may have only one parent/guardian attend Picture Day.** We kindly ask that no additional guests or siblings attend. Space will be very limited on Picture Day, and with our photographer's setup in place, we will not be able to accommodate extra people inside the studio.

Parents will be asked to remain in the waiting area during photo sessions. Only dancers will be permitted in the photo area. This helps keep the space calm, organized, and focused so each dancer can shine and enjoy their moment in front of the camera. Our team will take great care of the dancers and keep everything running smoothly!

Out of respect for our photographer and their work, no parent photography is allowed during photo sessions. Behind-the-scenes photos in the waiting area are welcome and encouraged – feel free to capture those sweet getting-ready moments!

Helpful Tips & Reminders

- No snacks or drinks (except water) inside the studio on Picture Day – our space is limited on Picture Day and we want to protect those beautiful costumes.
- Wear a large button-up or zip-up shirt over your dancer's costume instead of a t-shirt or hoodie to help protect their hair and keep everything photo-ready.
- Practicing hair and makeup ahead of Picture Day morning can make a big difference – it helps little dancers feel comfortable and keeps the morning calm, quick, and fuss-free on the big day!
- Always bring a few “fix-it” essentials to any recital event when in costume – like hairspray, hair ties, bobby pins, and lipstick. Little things can happen, and being prepared helps keep your dancer photo-ready and feeling confident all day long!

Preparing Your Costume

Costumes will be released starting **May 1** and can be signed out during your child's regular class. If your costume includes any special instructions or adjustments, please be sure to complete those before Picture Day.

Once costumes are signed out, we kindly ask that they are handled with great care at home. Please do not wear them for play, meals/snack, or everyday activities – this helps keep them in perfect condition for photos and recital. As a reminder, families are responsible for their costume once it has been signed out, and we are not able to replace costumes before the show.
